The tourist industry is generally considered to play a major role in supporting the economy of a region. Not only does tourism create jobs and contribute to increased employment, but it also introduces the local culture to visitors. In fact, “overtourism,” which refers to these and other negative effects of tourism, is becoming a problem in many parts of the world today.

The Impact of Color

Color is an important part of our environment and it is known to have a major effect on emotions and behavior. In fact, colors have a deep influence on human psychology—the way we think and feel, including how we react, respond, remember, and learn. Color psychology is a field of study that examines how colors influence emotions and behavior and what the preference for a certain color reveals about one’s personality. Some recent research indicates colors affect us in surprising ways.

Studies show that colors affect the way the brain performs different tasks. Between 2007 and 2008, researchers at the University of British Columbia in Canada conducted a test on 600 participants to see if the color of the computer screen affected their performance. One group was given the test

on a red screen and the other group took the same test on a blue screen. The group using the red screen did well on questions that required attention to detail, like correct spelling and remembering words. In contrast, the group working on the blue screen performed better on questions that called for imagination and creativity.
